

Propane FEED Program Extended Through 2010

The Propane Education & Research Council (PERC) announces its successful Propane FEED (Farm Equipment Efficiency Demonstration) program will return in 2010.

Launched last year, the Propane FEED program is a nationwide demonstration effort that offers a financial incentive to qualifying farmers to participate.

The Propane FEED program can save you up to \$2,500 on select pieces of propane equipment like irrigation engines, mowers, and tankless water heaters.

The development and commercialization of new propane technology remains a strategic goal for PERC, and the demonstration of new technology through programs such as this is a key step in that process.

The Propane FEED program pays farmers like you a financial incentive to demonstrate new propane equipment on your operation. New incentive levels were added to cover more irrigation engine sizes in 2010. See the chart below for current incentive levels.

Technology	Incentive
Irrigation Engine – 8 cylinder	\$2,500
Irrigation Engine – 6 cylinder	\$2,000
Irrigation Engine – 4 cylinder	\$1,500
Mower	\$2,500
Tankless Water Heater*	\$1,000

*At least two units must be installed.

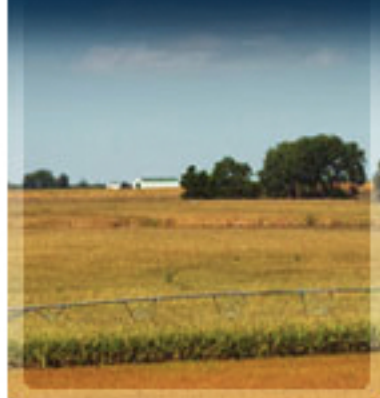
