To be eligible to win the vehicle, you must meet these qualifications:

- Use at least 1,500 gallons of propane annually on the farm.
- Use the fuel in an agricultural application, not for home heating or another non-farming purpose.
- Be a propane customer in good standing with your fuel supplier.
- Be a U.S. agricultural producer.
- Be a legal driver who is 21 years of age or older.

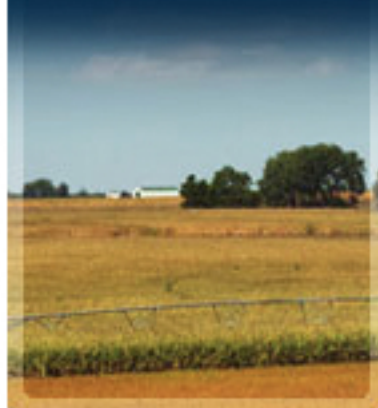
